
Known Facts in November

- Sitting square in between October and December, November is the eleventh month of the Gregorian calendar.

- Many people in the US can recall what they were doing at 12:30pm on
- November 22, 1963. It was on this day that President John F. Kennedy, known as JFK was fatally shot while riding along with his wife in a procession of cars. He was rushed to a hospital all too late and was pronounced dead at 1pm that day. Kennedy was the fourth US president to be assassinated, after Abraham Lincoln, James Garfield and William McKinley.
